90 The Avenue - BEES FLYING Gardens to the front, side and rear including lawns and borders. With curly hazel, ferns, fruit and vegetables and honey bee apiary. Plants, honey and candles will be on sale here. Display of Clayton Horticultural Society.

Rowanberries- Large grassed garden with flower beds and pots lovingly tended. Wooden structures like a planted pergola and decking add to the interest here. Refreshments available, donations for the Village Hall welcome.

1 Broomfield - Impressive gardens with gravelled and lawned areas surrounded by borders and pots. Take care with the large pond!

13 Fieldway – Tidy and peaceful garden with lawns, seated areas and borders planted with lots of flowers for pollinators. Lovely views on a clear day.

17 Town End - RESTRICTED PARKING A beautiful garden with lawn and planted borders bursting with colour. A delightful summer house really shows how you can appreciate your garden as the evening draws in.

27 John Street - A small immaculate garden at the front with maximised planting of many types of flowers making it attractive to pollinators.

29 John Street - Next to the above with stone flags, a large bed of lily of the valley, red currant bushes and a large wisteria climbing the house.

Heatherbrae, Chrisharben Park - RESTRICTED PARKING A cottage garden with big borders, a courtyard garden with pots, and a wildlife/fruit and vegetable garden with an array of bee friendly flowers and pond. Lots to take in.

2 Pinfold - Very well laid artificial grass with complimentary planting. Rockery and containers to the front, water features and impressive planters at the rear.

87 Pasture Lane - Sectioned gardens which have so many functions. Wildflowers, vegetable beds, mature fruit trees, rockery, chicken pen. There is a lot to appreciate in these gardens.

18 Pasture Rise – SUNDAY ONLY, RESTRICTED PARKING Beautifully bordered front garden and an extensive climbing rear garden including a wildlife pond, fruit bushes, raised vegetable planters. Parking is limited on Pasture Rise itself.
